The clinical laboratory science curriculum requires 94 semesters hours of preclinical courses and 10 to 18 month clinical rotation at one of the affiliate hospitals in Kansas City. Admission to the clinical portion of the training is by application and acceptance is not guaranteed. Students are required to have a minimum GPA of 2.0 to 2.5 for both overall work and for the required science courses. All of the requirements for the bachelor's degree must be complete before the student is allowed to sit for the certification examination.
