*A major consists of classes above the 200 level taken in the same language, except for Spanish. (Spanish courses apply beginning with SPAN 361.) With the exception of transfer credit or credit by examination that is approved by the dept, students who major in modern language must either (a) receive a grade of C or higher in all courses counted toward the major or (b) have a GPA of at least 2.50 in all courses counted toward the major. **Note** : Literature courses in translation may **not** be applied toward the major. Two non-transfer courses are required at the 700 level. SPAN 408 **does not** count towards the major.*
