College of Arts and Sciences Academic Engagement Scholarships (\$2000 per award)

This \$2000 scholarship is intended to benefit sophomore, junior, and senior undergraduates as well as graduate students who have invested and engaged in their education through research, classroom participation, extracurricular involvement, academic event attendance, or other activities. This is to recognize the hard work and dedication of students by providing awards of \$1000 for the Fall semester and \$1000 for the Spring semester. This scholarship also aims to aid students whose financial need is not being met through other venues.

In order to qualify, students must:

- Be an undergraduate or graduate student in the College of Arts and Sciences. If you are an undergraduate student, you must have reached the status of Sophomore by Fall 2019.
- Have a 2.0 or higher GPA when applying
- Demonstrate financial need

Application instructions:

- Your application should be double spaced, in 12-pt font, and should be submitted as a PDF in the order listed below.
- All applications need to be emailed to <u>artsci@ksu.edu</u> by March 18, 2019 at or before 11:59pm. No late applications will be accepted.

To apply:

- 1. Provide a resume, emphasizing work experience and academic engagement
- 2. Provide a 200 word statement explaining your financial need
- 3. Answer the following question in an 800-1000 word essay:
 - How have you actively engaged in your education inside and outside of the classroom?
 - What efforts have you made to support your education?
 - How would this scholarship impact the relationship between the two previous parts of this question?
