Pre-Health Information Management is not a degree-granting program. This guide is based on prerequisites for the professional program at the KU Medical Center. It takes two years to complete the prerequisites at KSU and another two years to complete the requirements for the Health Information Management degree from The University of Kansas. A minimum of 63 hours must be completed before entering the professional program. The minimum GPA for application is 2.5 calculated in three separate categories: Overall, Prerequisite, and Biological Sciences. No grade lower than a C is accepted in any prerequisite course.
